

Bangkok Declaration
The 30th General Conference
of The World Fellowship of Buddhists
18 - 21 October B.E. 2565 (2022)
Bangkok and Nakhon Pathom, Thailand

We, participants of the 30th General Conference of the World Fellowship of Buddhists held at Mahamakut Buddhist University, Bangkok , from 19 to 20 October B.E. 2565 (2022), with the theme “**Buddhism in the Time of Crisis**”, noting that persecution, violation of human rights and freedom, and discordance had undermined the happiness of mankind, do hereby determine :

1. To practice metta, compassion and wisdom in our human interaction, international relations, and care for the environment.
2. To respect diversity and multi-culturalism in our daily life.
3. To support the seventeen UN Sustainable Development Goals, particularly in the use of renewable energies, education for children and empowerment of women.
4. To participate in the conservation of Buddhist heritage sites and to promote heritage education.
5. To further engage in interfaith dialogues as a means to promote understanding and world peace.
6. To practice the Pancasila as way to fulfil our commitment to the mother earth.
7. To further propagate the Buddha Dhamma as a way to respect the sanctity of life and properties, and laying the foundation for a harmonious and peace world.
